

## LICENCE AGREEMENT ON THE USE OF THE WORK

The O.V. Palladin Institute of Biochemistry of NAS of Ukraine as a founder and publisher of the journal *The Ukrainian Biochemical Journal* (hereinafter referred to as Publisher) in the person of director S.V.Komisarenko, Academician of NAS of Ukraine, who acts on the basis of the Statute as one party and Author(s) (hereinafter referred to as Author) as the other party, the both, hereinafter referred to as Parties, have signed this Agreement as follows:

1. Author(s) give the Publisher a free exclusive license for printing and use of the written work (hereinafter referred to as Article) \_\_\_\_\_

including the rights to permit or ban using the Article or its part by the third parties in any form and by any means.

2. Since the time of signing this Agreement (on condition of taking the Article for press) the Publisher has the right to advertise, edit, adapt and modify, translate into other language, issue and distribute the Article in unlimited number in any form and format on various information carriers and in any way.

3. The License for the Article use is given the Publisher for the whole term of copyright for the above Article and is in force in the territory of countries all over the world.

4. Publisher acquires the right to sublicense the rights, obtained according to this Agreement, to other institutions and persons.

5. All the Article copies, both paper and electron (including CD, DVD and other electron means of mass information, Internet and other networks of data transfer and databases), have to include information about the Publisher's copyright and the right for complete bibliographic citing of the Article.

6. If the Article manuscript is not taken for press for 18 months (the Author being informed about that in written form) or is withdrawn by the author before taking the Article for press, the Agreement ceases to be effective and is terminated, and the Author is restored in his right.

7. The Publisher confirms that the following Author's rights are preserved:

- patent rights, rights for the trademark and rights for any processes, substances, and methods described in the Article;

- rights for making various copies, in particular electron copies, exceptionally for the Author's own use or by the Author's colleagues, provided that the Article copies will not be used for sale and for systematic distribution;

- rights for further use of the whole Article or some its parts by the Author in surveys, theses, books, lectures.

8. The Author guarantees that the Article was not published before and will not be published anywhere before its publication by the Publisher, and that the author's rights for its publication were not transferred to other publishers.

9. The Author guarantees that the Article is the Author's original work and is not a copy of any other work. The Author guarantees that he has obtained all the necessary permissions for the use of materials protected by Author's rights in his Article.

10. The Author guarantees that the Publisher's use of the author's rights obtained as a result of this Agreement will not cause the infringement of copyright of any persons or organizations, as well as will not result in the disclosure of secret or confidential information

11. The publisher has the right to determine the rules (conditions) of reception and publication of the Journal materials. The journal Editorial Board has the exclusive right to select and/or reject materials sent to the editorial office with the purpose of their publication. The manuscript sent by the Author (coauthors) to the editorial office is not subject to call. Editorial Stuff of the journal does not hold correspondence as to Article rejection by the Editorial Board. Publisher is responsible for not well-founded information supplied by Authors.

12. The Agreement is valid since the date of its signing by Parties and is concluded for the period of validity of the copyright for the Article. Relations unsettled by this Agreement are regulated by Law in force of Ukraine.

13. All additions, supplements, acts are made by Parties in writing and signed by authorized representatives of the Parties.
